

Why Pastors Get Fired

A new report on the forced terminations of pastors in Southern Baptist Churches (down 27 percent in the latest findings, but that did not include numbers from four states) included a more telling list: reasons churches give for firing the pastor.

10. conflict with other staff
9. sexual misconduct
8. administrative incompetence
7. weak leadership style
6. decline in attendance
5. conflict pre-dating the pastor's arrival
4. too strong leadership style
3. poor people skills

2. church's resistance to change

And the top reason (the same since the surveys began in 1996):

1. control issues. —Baptist Press
